

TONGHAM MOTOR CLUB
NUDGE AND SPIN RULES 2011.

Specifications:

1. Any 2 wheel drive saloon, hatchback or estate up to 1800 cc. Carburetor, injection, turbo and diesel engine allowed. Diesel engines must stop on cut off key. Gearbox suspension and diff must remain standard.
2. All lights, glass, interior, wheel weights and tow bars must be removed. Glass must be cut out rather than smashed. Sunroof area plated with body thickness material. Metal bumpers may remain, all plastic bumpers must be removed. Dash board may stay or be removed. Cars must be prepared prior to arrival at meeting.
3. Ignition switch accessible to driver and marked on and off. Steering lock removal is recommended. If retained key must be secured with cable or wire loop to keep it near the switch.
4. Isolator switch must be fitted to H Frame and be operational and must be marked on and off.
5. Full H frame recommended. Minimum requirement 2 across up and 1 across to form an H frame. H frame must be fitted tight to driver's seat as support.
6. Seat must be high backed, incorporate a head rest and be securely fitted.
7. Fully approved harness required with 4 point fixing but 5 point recommended, to be fitted to H frame or original mountings. By end of 2011 all Nudge and Spin Cars must be up to the latest specification with 5 point harness and 3 inch straps.
8. Radiators must be properly secured within the engine bay with breathers directed at track. No water tanks allowed. Anyone found with a water tank fitted after scrutineering will be loaded up.
9. Original fuel tank must be removed. Fuel tank of stout construction max 2 gallons fitted securely within H frame or within the vicinity of the H Frame floor. Must have a sealed filler cap and breather pipe from

top through floor. Good quality fuel pipes preferably braided to run inside car. Fuel taps must be fitted and be operational for both petrol and diesel cars.

10. No armoring allowed except drivers door plate which must be flat plate minimum 12.5 mm (1/2 INS) thick. Must not extend forward of front door pillar more than 150 mm (6 INS), or backwards of the rear pillar more than 450 mm (18 INS). Door plate must not protrude more than 50 mm (2 INS) no Armco. It must be secured with at least 6 bolts with large washers both sides through A and B pillars. Passenger doors must be tied shut not taped or bolted.
11. Battery covered and secured if in original position or secured in fastened battery box built within H frame. 12 volt only allowed maximum of 2 batteries.
12. Efficient exhaust system must be fitted with a minimum of two straps or chain bolted / welded to the underside of the car to support the exhaust system. Cars exceeding 98 decibels may be black flagged.
13. No distributor protection allowed.
14. All bulkhead holes must be sealed up.
15. Boot lid and bonnet must be tied. Rear of bonnet may be secured with 2 Small plates maximum 150 mm X 150 mm and body thickness to stop the bonnet going through the windscreen opening.
16. Screen mesh is compulsory max 25mm x 25mm half way across the wind screen opening to protect the driver. It is recommended that the Driver's side window be fitted with a door net.
17. Maximum wheel size 6J. Alloy wheels must be fitted with correct nuts and bolts. Tubes are recommended. Gaiters are optional. Tires are free except mud and snow or off road tyres . Punctures will be black flagged.
18. All drivers must wear overalls, gloves and crash helmet. Crash helmet must have the following BS numbers visible to the scrutineer: BS2495, 6658 Snell 70.80.90.ec22.05, p/j511884. With visor or goggles. Neck brace recommended.
19. Race numbers must be on doors, and roof sign must be black numbers on white background.
20. All cars must pass scrutineering and the scrutineer's word is final.

21. You must book in advance and you must hold a race license. Only 2 race meetings allowed on a day license.
22. All scrap metal, tyres and car parts must be removed on the day. Any driver not taking their parts with them will incur a fine and driver not allowed to race in any group until the fine paid.
23. You must spin into the infield and nudge around the corners only. Any follow ins or head ons will be loaded up, with no exceptions.
24. Any driver seen to be hot rodding will be penalized. If penalized twice a driver will be black flagged.
25. No driver to go to race control. If you are penalized the clerk of the course or drivers rep will inform you.
26. All 17 year olds must show birth certificate to race.
27. Remember Nudge and Spin is not Bangers and if you break the rules you will be LOADED UP. It is a fun day for drivers as well as members of the public to enjoy.
28. Member race day fee 5.00 Non member day license 20.00

TMC NUDGE AND SPIN
RACE DAY RULES AND PENALTIES.

1. You must book in advance with Alan Durbridge: Tel 01483 569410
2. Only 2 race meetings will be allowed on a day licence. No day licences will be issued for the August 2 day meeting.
3. All 17 year old drivers must show birth certificate.
4. All cars must pass scrutineering.
5. All drivers must wear overalls, gloves and crash helmet with BS numbers visible. BS2495, 6658 Snell 70.80.90, ec22.05, p/j511884, with visor or goggles. Neck brace recommended.
6. Drivers are responsible for the behaviour of their mechanics and guests.
7. You must Spin into the infield and Nudge around the corners only.

- 8.** You will be loaded up for fighting in the pits or on the track, following in, head on collisions, driving the wrong way around the track, deliberately going into drivers door, jacking up.
- 9.** Black flag will be shown for punctures, damaged or lost exhausts causing excessive noise, dangerous cars, or for your own safety.
- 10.** A warning will be given for swearing at officials and you will not be allowed out in the next race.
- 11.** A ban will only be issued after consultation with the committee. You may Submit a letter to be read to committee or may be invited to appear in person.
- 12.** No driver to go to race control.
- 13.** Penalties will be discussed by three race day officials and then issued by the Clerk of the Course.
- 14.** If you are not signed on you are not allowed to race.
